

Beginners 2 Curriculum Overview 2026-2027

Focus: language expansion, peer awareness, early academic exposure, and independence

Language & Social

- Uses short phrases or 2–3 word combinations
- Expresses feelings and needs verbally
- Engages in parallel play with peers
- Begins to take turns with teacher support

Independence & Routines

- Follows simple 1–2 step directions
- Participates in classroom routines with minimal assistance
- Begins to demonstrate independence in self-help skills (washing hands, helping clean up)

Cognitive

- Identifies basic colors and shapes
- Sorts objects by color, size, or type
- Begins to recognize some letters and numbers (1–5)
- Begins to recognize their name in print

Motor Skills

- Strengthens fine motor control (scribbling, using simple tools, puzzles)
- Develops gross motor coordination (jumping, running, balancing)

Early Literacy

- Enjoys listening to stories and songs
- Points to familiar objects or pictures in books
- Begins to participate in group reading time
